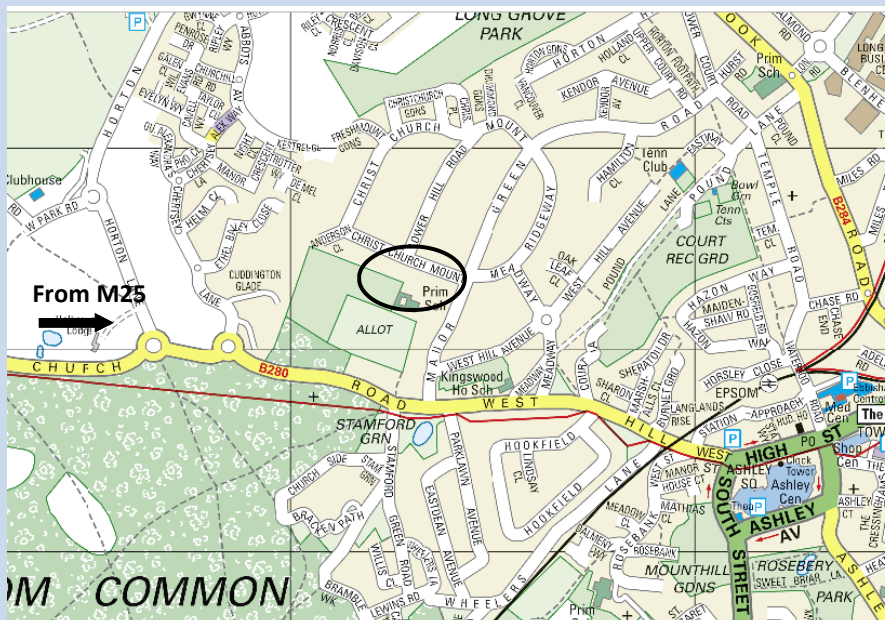

ARNIA Hive Monitoring System



The Arnia system provides remote monitoring of colony acoustics, hive weight, bee counts, brood temperature, hive humidity and also the weather! The talk will provide an overview of how the technology works and give examples of how the data generated is used.

George has been working for Arnia since 2012, helping to set up bee monitoring projects around the world and also analysing the bee data. He is also a hobby beekeeper with 5 hives of his own.



Driving – From the M25, follow the signs to Chessington World of Adventure (not Epsom). Turn right at the traffic junction after the BP garage. Take the 2nd exit at the next two roundabouts. Turn left after the pedestrian crossing into Manor Green Road. Take the first left into Christ Church Mount and the school is on your left. There is parking onsite and in the neighbouring roads.

Public Transport – the school is a 15 minute walk from Epsom Station
